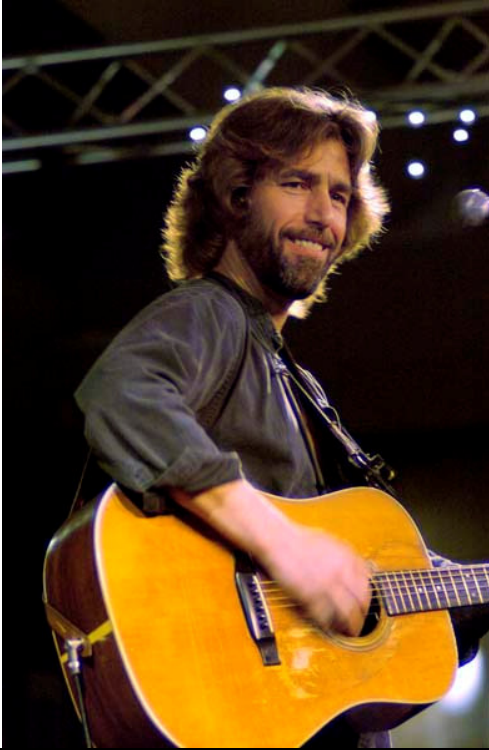

John Flynn – Passionate Singer-Songwriter

- Songwriter and activist John Flynn calls himself a "hopeful pessimist". The pessimism comes from a heartbreaking, clear-eyed honesty in assessing the condition of the world we live in. The hope comes from a deep-rooted faith in the beauty and resilience of the human spirit.
- In an artist of Flynn's caliber, the tension inherent in these seemingly contradictory points of view yields the kind of songs that moved Kris Kristofferson to compare Flynn to the best writers he knows, and Ramblin' Jack Elliott to boast "John Flynn is the John Lennon of the plasma generation!"
